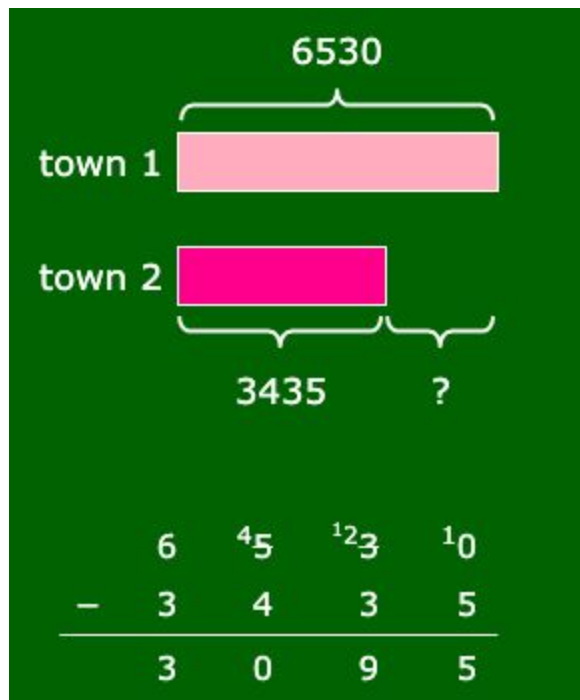

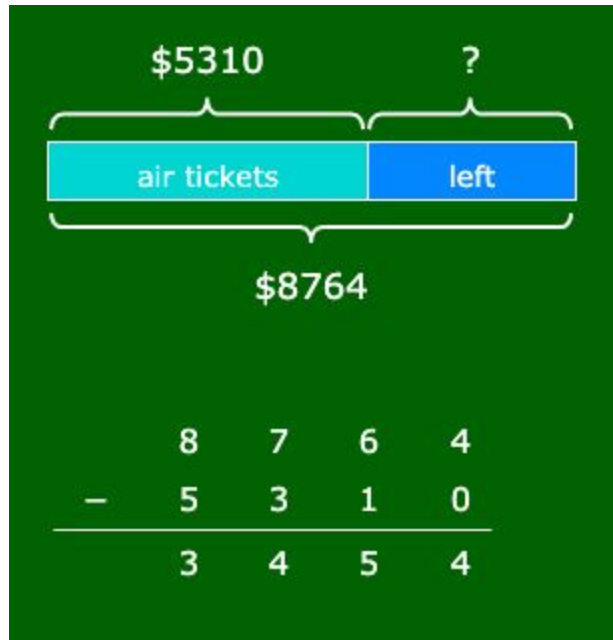

The difference between the number of residents in the two towns is 3095.

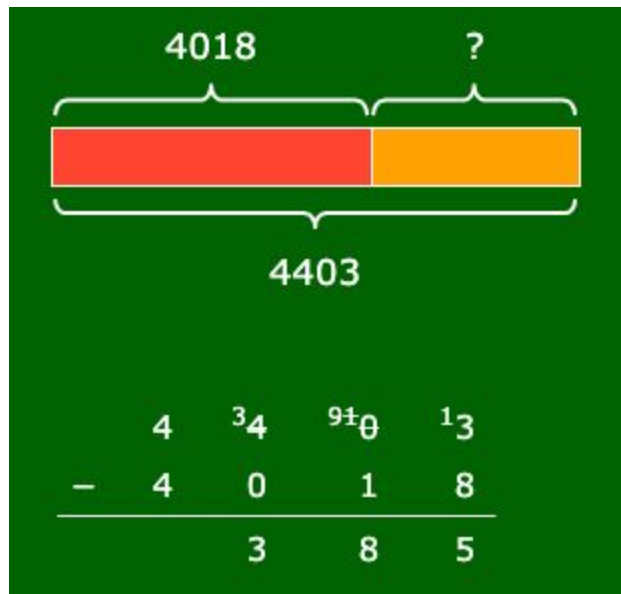

He had \$3454 left.

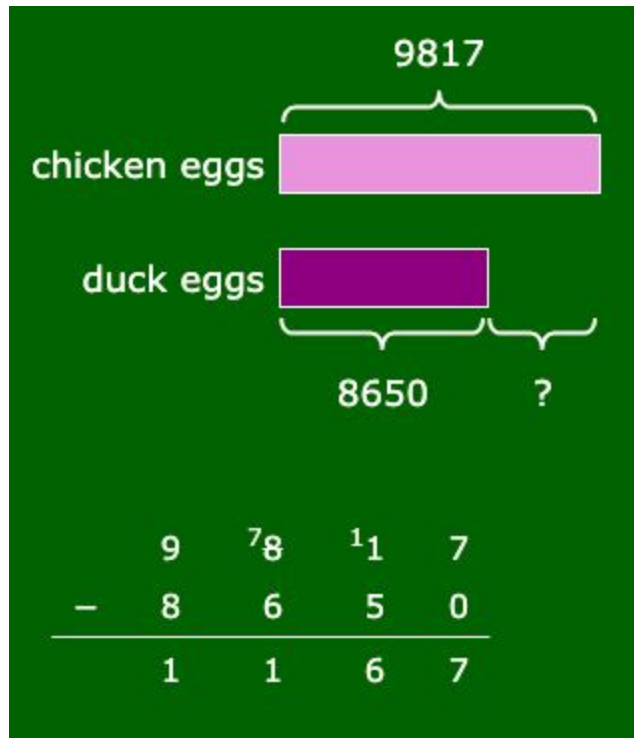

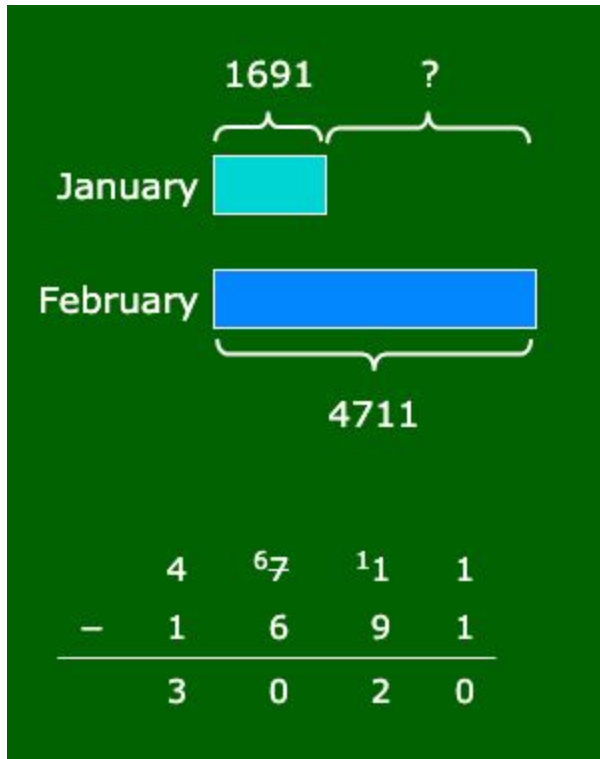

So, $9068 - 6661 = 2407$

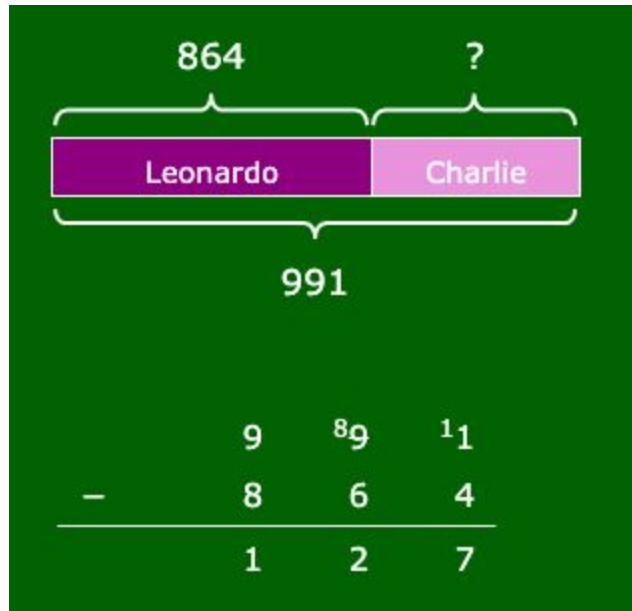
Problem 9
