SOLUTIONS

Problem 1

16 minutes past 4 is 16 minutes after 4 o'clock.

So, the time is 4.16.

Problem 2

3.20 is 20 minutes after 3 o'clock.

So, 3.20 is 20 minutes past 3.

Problem 3

$$1 \text{ hour} = 60 \text{ min}$$

$$60 \text{ min} - 35 \text{ min} = 25 \text{ min}$$

5.35 is 25 minutes before 6 o'clock.

So, 5.35 is 25 minutes to 6.



Problem 4

There are 5 minutes between two adjacent big markings on the clock.

$$8 \times 5 = 40 \text{ minutes}$$

The minute hand shows 40 minutes.

The hour hand is between 6 and 7.

So, the time is 6.40.

He has his dinner at 6.40.

Problem 5

Each small marking on the clock stands for 1 minute.

The minute hand shows 03 minutes.

The hour hand is between 2 and 3.

So, the time is 2.03.
