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1. Britney paid \$40 in various bills.

She paid \$12.15 for food, \$10.45 for taxi and the rest for groceries.

How much did she pay for groceries?

2. Stacey has some money.

Her brother has \$83.60.

If she buys a scrapbook for \$12.10, she will have \$43.55 less than her brother.

How much does she have?

Mrs. Jordan earned \$38.85.

Mrs. Gray earned \$6.70 less than Mrs. Jordan.

Then she saves another \$24.10.

She wants to buy a superhero costume that costs \$82.65.

A water bottle that has a usual price of \$15.35 is selling at a discounted price of \$9.20.

Juan buys two such water bottles.

How much discount does he receive altogether?

## SOLUTIONS

### Problem 1



$$\$12.15 + \$10.45 = \$22.60$$

Britney paid \$22.60 for food and taxi.

$$\$40.00 - \$22.60 = \$17.40$$

She paid \$17.40 for groceries.



**Problem 2**



$$\$43.55 - \$12.10 = \$31.45$$

Stacey has \$31.45 less than her brother.

$$\$83.60 - \$31.45 = \$52.15$$

She has \$52.15.



**Problem 3**



$$\$38.85 - \$6.70 = \$32.15$$

Mrs. Gray earned \$32.15.

$$\$38.85 + \$32.15 = \$71.00$$

They earned \$71.00 altogether.



**Problem 4**



$$\$24.05 + \$24.10 = \$48.15$$

She has \$48.15 altogether.

$$\$82.65 - \$48.15 = \$34.50$$

She must save \$34.50 more to buy the superhero costume.



**Problem 5**



$$\$15.35 - \$9.20 = \$6.15$$

He receives a discount of \$6.15 on one water bottle.

$$\$6.15 + \$6.15 = \$12.30$$

He receives a discount of \$12.30 altogether.
